

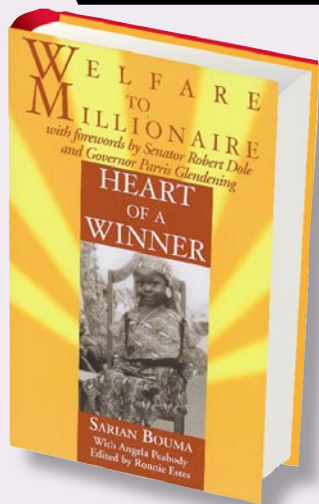

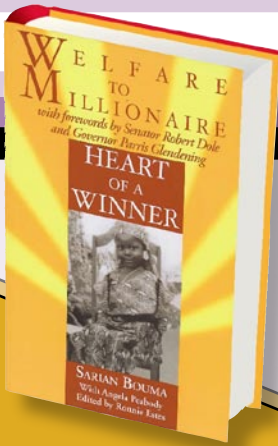

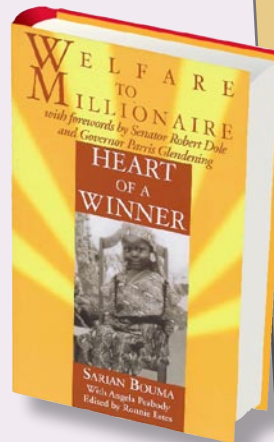
SARIAN BOUMA!

Born in Freetown, Sierra Leone, Sarian Bouma came to America in search of a better life. Employed at a radio station in her country, she came to America to go to college. Shortly after moving to Washington, D.C., she met the love of her life, married him, got pregnant, and put off her education. A year later, when he left her, she had no savings and no job; she and her son ended up in a homeless shelter.

One day, she went to the store to buy milk and was turned away at the counter because she didn't have enough food stamps. That night, she had to fill her son's bottle with water, and that was the "electric shock" she needed to realize that this was not the life she had come to America to pursue. It was time to take responsibility and let go of the past.
